## Guidelines to Authors

**Journal of Animal Health Production and Technology**, the official journal of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University Tirupati publishes review articles, research articles, scientific papers, research notes, case reports, short communications covering different subjects of veterinary, animal, dairy and fishery sciences twice in a year.

### General Instructions

- Articles neither published nor being considered elsewhere for publication are only advised to be submitted to this journal.
- All the contributors should sign on a certificate to that effect.
- The Editorial board has got the right to accept or reject a manuscript based on reviewer's comments/ general suitability/ standards and ethical grounds of the journal. Decision of the Editorial board is final in all matters in connection with publication of manuscript.
- It is mandatory that every author should be a subscriber/member of the journal.
- Each manuscript will be allotted a registration number for further correspondence.

### Manuscript Preparation and Submission

- Manuscript should be in English, typed in Times New Roman, Font size 12 on A4 size paper in double space on one side of the page, not exceeding 12, 15 and 8 pages (including, tables, illustration and references) for review article, research article and research note/ case reports, respectively.
- The cover page of the manuscript should have the title of the paper, names of the authors, their affiliation, and complete postal address. The designations and email IDs of the corresponding author and co-authors should also be mentioned in the bottom. The title of the manuscript should start with first letter in capital. The authors name should be followed by the initials which will be followed by the next author in a similar way.

Example:

Study on microbial pattern of isolates from clinical mastitis  
Kishore Kumar G.K<sup>1</sup> and Raghuram Bhat M<sup>2</sup> .

- If the paper is a part of post graduate and doctoral thesis, it should be mentioned.
  - The manuscript should not contain name(s) and addresses of author(s) anywhere in the manuscript. The title should be followed by the **abstract not more than 300 words** for the review article and research papers.
  - Mention maximum of **five key words for review and research article, three words for research note/case report**.
  - **Research article** should have brief introduction, material and methods, results and discussion, references and tables with headings. All headings should be typed in capitals and centered.

- **Research note and case reports** should have brief introduction, material and methods, results and discussion in a single section without headings along with references and tables (not exceeding two).
- **References** should be cited in the text by the names of the authors followed by the year of publication. References should be listed alphabetically. The authors name should be followed by the initials (author name first letter should be written in capital) the year of publication in parenthesis, title in lower case, journal name in full form, volume number and page numbers in bold letters.

Eg. Singh, S. K., Suresh, V. P., Madhubabu, D. C. and Sinha, A., (2000). Bacteriological studies of mastitis in cross bred cows. Indian Veterinary journal., **22: 261-264.**

**While citing from books:** should include author name, year of publication, title of the chapter, name of the text book, author/ editor, edition, publishers name, place of publication, pages cited.

Eg, Ramakrishna, O. (1993) Cardio vascular system in the text book of Ruminant Surgery edited by Tyagi R P S and Jit singh (2<sup>nd</sup> edition) CBS publishers New Delhi; **34-55**

**While citing from Thesis:** should include, author name, year, title, PG/PhD Thesis, name of University.

Eg, Govinda R (1994) Studies on Rabies with special reference to epidemiology in dogs Ph.D thesis approved by Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati.

- **Tables and illustrations:** should be on separate sheets, numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals (Table: 2/ Fig.2) and with short descriptive heading for tables and legends for illustrations in sentence case. Units, symbols and abbreviations used in table should conform to the international system.
- **Photographs and photomicrographs:** should be of good contrast. Magnification for photomicrographs should be indicated. All illustrations should have the first authors name and the figure number on right top of the back side of the picture..
- **Fee :** The Author shall pay a processing fee of Rs. 200-00. Charges for Printing of colour photos and reprints extra.
- **Animal experimentation :** All the research work involving animal experimentation should be in accordance with the guide lines issued by CPCSEA.
