The establishment of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University was the culmination of efforts during the period, 1955 to 2005 to strengthen education and services in the fields of Veterinary Science, Dairy Technology and Fishery Science in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The establishment of

four Veterinary Colleges, the first at Bapatla during 1955, the second at Gannavaram during 1998, the third at Proddatur during 2008 and the fourth at Garividi during 2016, paved the way for strengthening Veterinary education in the state. The Veterinary College at Bapatla was shifted to Tirupati during December, 1957. The College of Fishery Science was started at Muthukur, Nellore district during 1991. The Dairy Technology Programme was started in 1983 at the College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati and was elevated to college status during June, 2009. The University was created during the year 2005 by bifurcating the faculty of Veterinary Science comprising of Veterinary Science, Fishery Science and Dairy Science from Acharya N.G. Ranga Agriculturial University, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. The then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Dr. Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy inaugurated Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University in the premises of College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati on 15 July 2005 coinciding with the valedictory function of Golden Jubilee celebrations of College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati.

Submission of Abstracts: Abstracts with title, author(s) name, email, name of the institution, objectives, methods, results and conclusions (not exceeding 300 words) using MS word 2007, Times New Roman (Font size 12 in double space) should be forwarded electronically to HYPERLINK mail to: isvctirupati2019@gmail.com before 30-09-2019. Abstracts of paper should be based on the original work/concept of the authors and must not have published anywhere. Name of the presenting author should be underlined. Only quality papers will be selected for presentations in the relevant technical sessions. Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by a scientific committee and decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be communicated to the corresponding authors.

Awards: Best presentation awards will be given away in farm animal cardiology, companion animal cardiology and poster sessions.

Presentations : Oral: Only by power point, not exceeding 20min for lead papers and 5 min for other papers followed by $2 \min$ of discussion for each.

Poster: Poster size should be $150 \, \mathrm{cm}$ width and $90 \, \mathrm{cm}$ height and the presenters should bring their own pins for display of the poster on the board. The poster should be informative and self explanatory with attractive look.

Passport and Visa: All overseas participants/delegates are advised to make their own arrangements with respect to entering India. Check this matter carefully with respective airline or travel agent as immigration laws are strictly enforced.

Official language: The official language for the conference is English. No translation services will be available.
