Candidates must download the application form with information brochure placed in www.svvu.edu.in and appear in person with duly filled in application for spot admission

from 06.02.2023 to 10.02.2023 during 10.30 AM to 5.00 PM at Office of the Controller of Examination, Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Administrative Office, Dr.Y.S.R.Bhavan, Tirupati. Candidates must pay registration fee of Rs.600/- (Rs.300/- In case of SC/ST candidates) by cash at Counseling centre or in the form of demand draft drawn from any Nationalized Bank in favour of Comptroller, Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, payable at Tirupati. The candidates must appear for spot admission along with all original certificates.

Note: a) In event of non-availability of candidates in any category, the same will be converted as per the rule of reservations.
b) Further the unfilled seats under ICAR quota if any in due course may be filled from the merit list of applications received in this notification.

Qualifications and eligibility:

1. B.Tech (DT): A pass in 2 years intermediate in MPC stream and Qualified in **APEAPCET-2022**.
2. The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December 2022 and upper age limit is 22 years (25 years in case of SC & ST candidates).
3. The criteria of selection is based on merit in **AP EAPCET** ranking.

Reservation of Seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturists under farmers quota:

- 25% seats in this course are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists engaged in and owning not less than 1 acres of land and who have studied for a minimum of 4 Years in Schools/ Institution located in Non-Municipal areas. Candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a certificate in Form-I of application with patta numbers and extent of land obtained from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer and also a Certificate in Form-II of application from the Head Master of the School/ Institution that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in Schools/ Institution located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class/Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate)
- If Form-I & Form-II of the application are not filled in and not signed by the concerned Officer (MRO/Head Master) with office seal, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

LIST OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED:

1. Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its equivalent)
2. Hall Ticket & Rank Card of AP EAPCET -2022.
3. SSC or equivalent certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.

4. In case of the candidates belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, latest certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority.
5. In case of the candidates claiming Economically Weaker Section (EWS), latest EWS certificate issued by the competent authority.
6. Bonafide /Study Certificates from 6th to 12th Class.
7. Residential Certificate.

Note: Such of the students who are having a break in the years of study for reasons other than failure or those who passed the qualifying examination by private study have to submit this certificate issued by the Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.

In case, the students have resided in more than one place, separate certificate from the Mandal Revenue Officer/ Tahsildar, should be furnished for such places of residence.

8. Forms required for the candidates eligible under Farmers Quota seats:
 - a) **FORM-I** : It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate/ parents (Father /Mother only) duly certified by the **Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar with office seal** (or) the candidate has to enclose **pattadar pass book** as an evidence of the extent of land.
 - b) **FORM-II**: It is a proforma to be certified by the **Head Master** of the School with office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in school(s) located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class/ Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**).

Note: Candidates are requested to come prepared to pay the fee in cash as per the fee structure of the university if got admission in Spot admissions process as detailed below.
