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From the Desk of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor

TIME TO SUSTAINABLE APPROACH/ THE WAY FORWARD

I feel it is important at this moment to suggest the importance of cultivation of fodder crops during this Kharif season and better utilization of crop residues resulted from Rabi season. The Scientists who are working in the fields of feeding of livestock and better utilization of feeds and fodders shall focus on these issues.

It is pertinent to note that the state of Andhra Pradesh ranks 5th in milk production and 2nd in meat production contributing 6.75% of revenue for the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP). Livestock sector is providing livelihood to a huge number of 60 lakh families and still has potentiality to grow further.

Development of fodder resources is an important issue in view of declining resources of fodder cultivation to make livestock keeping more remunerative and sustainable. One of the major challenges the state is facing is the huge shortage of green fodder (41%), concentrate feeds (42%) and dry fodder (20%). Hence the concerned scientists should thrive to bridge this huge gap.

On the other side, I would like to share with you regarding some of the significant events that took place during the period under report through this newsletter.

It gives me immense pleasure to announce that Hon'ble Minister of Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries, Dr. Seediri Appalaraju garu has inaugurated the newly constructed University Library building at an estimated cost of Rs. 705 lakh and a state of art e-conference hall at an estimated cost of Rs. 95 lakh attached to it. The buildings were inaugurated on 27th July 2022 in the presence of Hon'ble local MLA's members of Board of Management. NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON CLINICAL DIAGNOSTIC TECHNIQUES AND CLINICAL CASE CONFERENCE IN VETERINARY PRACTICE

The ability to diagnose acquired systemic diseases in farm and companion animals is an active area of ongoing research. Clinical diagnostic techniques are widely used in human medicine, but they are only used in Teaching Veterinary Hospitals in the veterinary field. To familiarize faculty/scientists and veterinary practitioners with non-invasive diagnostic techniques to aid in the diagnosis of systemic diseases in farm and companion animals, the College of Veterinary Science, Proddatur organized a one-day National workshop on "Clinical Diagnostic Techniques in Veterinary Practice" on 28th July, 2022 at Golden Park Function Hall, Proddatur. A total of 54 delegates comprising Veterinary Assistant Surgeons, Faculty, and Veterinary Practitioners from Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, and Karnataka attended the workshop.
