ICAR - NAARM SPONSORED 5DAY TRAINING PROGRAMME ON VALUE ADDITION OF MILK AND MEAT

Dr. K. Sujatha, Professor & Coordinator of CCVEC, Tirupati acted as Training Coordinator and conducted an ICAR-NAARM sponsored 5-day Entrepreneurial Skill Development training program on "Value addition of milk and meat products" for SC women farmers at CCVEC from $11^{\text{th}} - 15^{\text{th}}$ December 2023. In this program, 20 SC women farmers of Akkurthi, Yellampalli, and Vagaveedu

villages of Erpedu Mandal, Tirupati district are participants.

The women were educated about the control of milk adulteration, clean milk production, the importance of value addition of milk and the preparation of Khoa was explained with hands - on training on the preparation of Khoa - based milk products like Khoa, Basundi, Gulab Jamun, and Channa-based sweets like Rasagulla, Rasamalai, etc. An exposure visit was organized to the local unit of the Balaji Dairy plant. Awareness was created about milk - borne and meat - borne diseases, the scientific slaughter of birds to improve meat quality, and utilization of slaughterhouse waste. The importance of the value addition of meat and eggs was explained with hands-on training in the preparation of meat emulsion and products like sausages, nuggets, and meatballs, chicken and mutton pickles, egg-based products, and fish products preparation.
