From the Desk of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor

WAY FORWARD/ SUSTAINABLE APPROACHES

The livestock sector as we all know, a key component of India's agriculture, contributing significantly to the country's Gross Value Addition (GVA). However, this industry suffers significant economic losses from time to time as a result of various infectious diseases. You must be aware that lumpy skin disease is a transboundary emerging viral disease affecting cattle and buffaloes and spreads quickly and is difficult to control. According to reports, more than one lakh cattle, both native and crossbred got affected in nearly 251 districts across 15 Indian states and union territories with considerable drop in milk production in affected states leading to trade restrictions on the export of animal products, resulting in massive losses to the meat, milk and leather industries and thus the small and large farmers incurred huge financial losses alike.

The Departments of Animal Husbandry and dairying has taken necessary steps at state and centre level to contain the spread of LSD including vaccinating animals with the Goat Pox Vaccine (GPV) and regularly monitoring and treating infected cattle, banning cattle shandies and restricting interstate animal movement.

It is not out of place to report that, Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati diagnosed the disease for the first time in the state during the 2019 outbreak. During these difficult periods of viral out break our scientists are fully engaged, in the control of LSD supported by our state of art diagnostic laboratories, in the state by raising awareness among farmers through village-level farmers interaction meetings, TV & AIR programs. I sincerely appreciate the efforts of the SVVU scientists involved in this program.

It is my sincere appeal to all the scientists, field veterinarians and NGOs to extend all energies to combat epidemic and to make all efforts to win the battle against Lumpy Skin Disease to save our livestock from this epidemic of economic importance.

Early detection of LSD, as well as effective disease surveillance, use of appropriate diagnosis and adoption of suitable preventive strategies are some of the remedial measures for successful control of this epidemic in our state as well as in the country.

Thirty Scheduled Caste women farmers from Akkurthi and Uranduru villages of Srikalahasthi Mandal, Tirupati district, Andhra Pradesh participated in the program. The women participated actively in all sessions of the program and were educated on various aspects of backyard poultry rearing. The Programme was inaugurated under the guidance of Dr. G. Venkata Naidu, Director of Extension with the presence of University officers. Dr. M. Balakrishnan, Scientist, NAARM and Dr. K. Sujatha, Co-ordinator, CCVEC acted as Programme Coordinators.

A team of experts from the University namely, Dr. S. Shakeela, Dr. G. Gangaraju, Dr. Tirupati Reddy, Dr. Triveni, Dr. Sudheer, and Dr. K. Sujatha explained various topics like, breeds and managemental practices of backyard poultry, economical rearing of quails, managemental practices of Layers, marketing channels, economics and expenditure, preparation and marketing of value addition of chicken meat/egg products and important infectious diseases of poultry & its control respectively. Finally, each participant received a training certificate, 20 Vanaraja chicks (two months old), a waterer, a feeder, and a bird crate. The farmers also received a training kit.
