#### COLLEGE OF VETERINARY SCIENCE TIRUPATI

# RESEARCH ACTIVITIES LIVESTOCK RESEARCH STATION, LAM, GUNTUR

A total of 144 (14 Ongole and 130 Punganur) semen doses from high genetic merit (HGM) bulls were supplied to the farmers. A total of 25 HGM Ongole semen doses were issued for use in LRS Lam. Six HGM Ongole donors and two HGM Gir donors were aspirated for oocytes. Twenty five HGM Ongole and 26 HGM Gir IVF embryos were produced. Two IVF embryos of HGM Gir were fresh transferred. Thirty Nine HGM IVF Gir and 9 HGM IVF Ongole embryos were supplied to the field. 63,107 Ongole and 3183 Punganur Frozen semen doses were available in the Semen Bank. 417 Ongole and 32 Gir IVF Embryos are available in Embryo Bank.

## COLLEGE OF DAIRY TECHNOLOGY TIRUPATI

As per the request received from the Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, the University authorities directed the College of Dairy Technology, Tirupati to analyze the milk samples from AMUL-AMCs of Pulivendula region of Kadapa district and a few selected milk collection centers of Nellore District to apply for the Geographical Indication (GI) of goods for the milk of Pulivendula region.
