A full fledged state of art Digital studio with Edit suit, sound proof facility and sound mixing software has been established at SVVU, Tirupati. This digital studio will help to prepare multimedia modules for the benefit of farming and teaching and student community.

ENDOWMENT LECTURE

Late Dr. Kanumuri Venugopal Naidu Memorial Biennial Endowment Lecture- 2020 was delivered by eminent Veterinary scientist Dr. Suresh S. Hannappagol, a renowned Veterinary Gynaecologist formerly Commissioner of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of India and former Vice-chancellor of KVAFSU, Bidar. The Endowment lecture was instituted by Smt. K. Ramadevi, wife of Late Dr. Kanumuri Venugopal Naidu with a corpus fund of Rs 3 lakhs in the year 2017. The endowment lecture titled "Role of Application of Assisted Reproductive Technologies(ARTs) in Doubling Farmers Income" was delivered on 26. 03. 2021 at the college auditorium CVSc, Tirupati. The lecture was well attended by more than 200 enthusiastic faculty, field veterinarians and post graduate and under graduate students.

Dr. Kanumuri Venugopal Naidu was born on 12.05.1955 in Konganavaripalle village of Chandragiri Mandal, Chittoor district. He graduated from College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati in the year 1980 from the same college. He obtained PhD from TANUVAS, Chennai in the year 1991 with ICAR Senior Research Fellowship. He joined the AP Agriculture University as Faculty Member on 14-03-1983 at College of Veterinary Science, Rajendra Nagar and later served from 07-12-1984 at College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati and SVVU Head quarters. He was elevated as

Professor on 26-12-2003 and as senior professor on 26-12-2013. He served as founder Associate Dean, College of veterinary science, Proddatur from 24-08-2008 to 23-11-2009. He guided 10 MVSc and 3 PhD scholars. He published 69 research papers and was chairman of Animal Reproduction and Gynaecology group to review the syllabus of ARS/NET. He was recipient of University meritorious Teacher Award (2000), Young Scientist Award of Indian Society for Advancement of Animal Reproduction (1992), Neils Lagerlof Gold Medal (1981) for securing highest OGPA in MVSc (1981). He was Controller of Examinations of SVVU from 25-06-2011 to 11-11-2016. He was also Member, Board of Management, SVVU, Tirupati. He breathed his last on 12-11-2016 in a tragic road accident. He was survived by Wife, Son and a daughter.
